

## Stockholm Trophy 2022 - Annex 2

### SENIOR B, women, born 30/6 2006 and earlier, ISU evaluation

Free program 3 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

Maximum 7 jump elements, Axel must be included

Maximum 3 jump combination or jump sequences. Max. 1 combination may consist of 3 jumps and the other jump combinations may contain max. 2 jumps. Only 2 jumps with 3 or more revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Single or double jump, including 1A, may be attempted twice (jumps do not need to be attempted in a jump combination or jump sequence) Maximum 3 different spins (every spin has to have different abbreviation!) 1 spin combination (10 revolutions) with or without change of foot. 1 spin with one position (min. 6 revolution). 1 flying spin (min. 6 revolutions)

1 Step sequence must fully utilize the ice surface.

### JUNIOR A, Woman and Men, age end requirements according to ISU

Short program and free program

### JUNIOR B, Woman and Men, born 1/7 2002-30/6 2007 ISU evaluation

Free program: 3 min, +/- 10 sec.

Maximum 6 jump elements, Single axel must be included **Double Axel is not permitted!**

Maximum 3 jump combination or jump sequences. Max. 1 combination may consist of 3 jumps and the other jump combinations may contain max. 2 jumps. Only 2 jumps with 3 or more revolutions can be repeated either in a jump combination or in a jump sequence. Single or double jump, including 1A, may be attempted twice (jumps do not need to be attempted in a jump combination or jump sequence) Max. 2 different spins (every spin has to have different abbreviation!) 1 spin combination (10 revolutions) with or without change of foot. 1 spin with one position with change of foot (min. 8 revolution) or without change of foot (min. 6 revolutions).

1 Step sequence must fully utilize the ice surface.

For Junior B, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 3 will be counted. Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

### JUNIOR C, Women, born 1/7 2002-30/6 2007, Swedish Star evaluation

Free program maximum 3 minutes but can be shorter

Elements are free of choice but **maximum 2 different double jumps are allowed and they cannot be repeated more than twice. 2A, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category**

### ADVANCED NOVICE, girls and boys, age and requirements according to ISU

Short program and Free program

### NOVICE B, girls and boys born 1/7 2006-30/6 2009 IUS evaluation

Free program maximum 3 min +/- 10 sec

Maximum of 5 jump elements, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to 2 jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only 2 jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.

Any single or double jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

Maximum of 2 spins, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum 8 revolutions) and one must be a flying spin with no change of position (minimum 6 revolutions without change of foot and 8 revolutions with change of foot).

There must be one step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

For Novice B, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 3 will be counted.

Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

**Double Axel is not allowed!**

### NOVICE C, girls and boys, born 2006 or later, Swedish Star evaluation

Free program maximum 2 min 30 sec but can be shorter

Elements free of choice **but maximum 2 different double jumps are allowed and they cannot be repeated more than twice. 2A, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category**

**DEBS B, girls and boys, born 1/7 2008-30/6 2011, Swedish rules, see annex 2**

Free program, 3 min +/- 30 sec

Maximum of 5 jump elements, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to 2 jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only 2 jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.

Any single or double jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

Maximum of 2 spins, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum 8 revolutions) and one must be a flying spin with no change of position (minimum 6 revolutions without change of foot and 8 revolutions with change of foot).

There must be one step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

For Debs B, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 3 will be counted. Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

**Double Axel is not allowed!**

**DEBS C, girls and boys, born 2008 or later, Swedish Star evaluation**

Free program maximum 2 min 30 sec but can be shorter

Elements free of choice **but maximum 2 different double jumps are allowed and they cannot be repeated more than twice. 2A, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category**

**SPRINGS A, girls and boys, born 2009 or later, Swedish rules see annex 2**

Free program, 3 min +/- 10 sec

Maximum of 5 jump elements, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to 2 jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only 2 jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.

Any single or double jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

Maximum of 2 spins, one of which must be a spin combination (minimum 8 revolutions) and one must be a spin with only one position (minimum 6 revolutions without change of foot and 8 revolutions with change of foot).

Flying entry is possible on both spins.

There must be one step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

For Springs A, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 3 will be counted.

Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

**SPRINGS B, girls and boys, born 2010 or later, ISU evaluation**

Free program, 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

Maximum of 4 jump elements, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to 2 jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only 2 jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.

Any single or double jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

There must be a maximum of 2 spins, one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin in only one position, both spins can have flying entry and change of foot, with a change of foot minimum of 8 revolutions or without a change of foot minimum of 6 revolutions. There must be one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

For Springs B, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted.

Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

**Maximum 2 different double jumps are allowed and they cannot be repeated more than twice. 2A, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category**

**SPRINGS C, girls and boys, born 2010 or later, Swedish Star evaluation**

Free program, maximum 2 min 30 sec but can be shorter

Elements are free of choice but **double jumps are not allowed!**

**CUBS A, girls and boys, born 2012 or later, ISU evaluation**

Competition only in Free program, 2 min 30 sec +/- 10 sec

Maximum of 4 jump elements, one of which must be an Axel type jump. There may be up to 2 jump combinations or sequences. A jump combination can contain only 2 jumps. A jump sequence can contain any number of jumps, but only two most difficult jumps will be counted.

Any single or double jump cannot be executed more than twice in total.

There must be a maximum of 2 spins, one of which must be a spin combination and one must be a spin in only one position, both spins can have flying entry and change of foot, with a change of foot minimum of 8 revolutions or without a change of foot minimum of 6 revolutions. There must be one (1) step sequence fully utilizing the ice surface.

For Cubs A, in all elements that are subject to Levels, only features up to Level 2 will be counted. Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.

Single Axel and one double jump are allowed and they cannot be repeated more than twice.  
2A, 2F and 2Lz – are not allowed in this category

### **ICE DANCE BEGINNERS, couples of all ages**

**Pattern Dance Rhythm Blues** - Blues 4/4; Tempo 22 measures of 4 beats (88 beats per minute) plus or minus 2 beats per minute; Set Pattern; 3 Sequences

**Freedance** - 1 min and 30 sec +/- 10 sec

One spin or combination spin

One Combination Set of Twizzles

Two Choreographic Elements: One Choreographic Character Step Sequence and one additional chosen from: - Choreographic Lift - Choreographic Spinning Movement - Choreographic Twizzling Movement

**Levels explanation:** In all Required Elements (except Choreographic Element), Level 1 is the maximum level the couple may receive for all required elements.

Only features up to Level 1 will be counted. Any additional features will be ignored by the Technical Panel.
