Dear skating friends, we are pleased to send you an invitation to our annual Figure Skating Competition in Stockholm, Sweden. After four years with no Inter Club competition in Stockholm we are happy to invite you once again. This competition is sanctioned by the Swedish Figure Skating Association. Date: 3 – 6 March 2022

Place of competition: Nacka Ice Rink (30 x 60 m), heated

Entries:

All ISU members and clubs, members of National Figure Skating Federations associated with ISU, are invited to take part in the competition. The organizer reserves the right to limit the number of participants in case the number of competitors is too high. The organizing club reserves the right to enter more competitors. The clubs are asked to list the skaters in the order in which they wish to be accepted to the competition. We will divide the categories into smaller groups according to age if necessary.

Judges: Each invited member or club with entries in at least three categories may nominate one International Judge or ISU Judge. The organizer reserves the right to select the judges. The organizer will pay for accommodation and meals for the selected judges.

Deadline for entries: All entries (competitors, judges, team leaders, coaches) are expected to be Emailed and received at organizer's address not later than **January 31**. Enclosed entry form must be used. OC: Pia Pettersson, E-mail Stockholmtrophy2022@gmail.com

Svenska klubbar anmäler i IndTA som vanligt. Vi stänger första intaget 31/1. Finns det platser kvar öppnar vi för efteranmälan – ingen dubbel avgift. Isdanspar anmäler sig via anmälningsblankett, inte via IndTA.

Expenses: The organizer covers the expenses for the competition, awards and presents. Transfer expenses to and from Stockholm and accommodation will not be covered by the organizer. The organizer will provide medical emergency aid during the competition.

Liability: The organizing committee accepts no responsibility or liability with respect to bodily or personal injury, property loss or damage suffered by the competitors or officials during the competition, according to ISU rule 119. The organizer will not cover any extra costs in case of covid restrictions forcing us to cancel the event.

Language: The official language is English

Music: Music will be reproduced by mp3 files, link for uploading mp3 files will be provided after confirmation to all participants. Musiken laddas från IndTA som vanligt för Svenska åkare.

Calculation of results: ISU judging system and Swedish Star system, for details see Annex 2.

Awards: The three best placed competitors in each category will be awarded special presents, all others diplomas. Victory ceremony for the podium will be held on ice if nothing else is stated by the OC.

Charges: SEK 550 is to be paid for each competitor in categories with Swedish Star evaluation, SEK 650 is to be paid for IJS categories with only free skating and SEK 850 for categories with short + free IJS. Ice Dance 850 SEK/couple.

Payment must be paid in advance after confirmation no later than **February 20**

Accommodation: All participants, except invited judges, have to pay for the accommodation themselves.

All participants make their own reservations with the hotel. The organizer has reserved facilities at the official hotel; prices are per room and night including breakfast will be given in the beginning of January. We are negotiating with the hotels now.

Covid-19: When submitting an entry all competitors acknowledge that due to the Covid-19 pandemic situation and public health issues in Sweden the Organizers can only host the competition in accordance with the effective medical and government regulations and has the solemn right to cancel the competition at any time or to host it between closed doors with a limited number of competitors and no spectators. The competitors also acknowledge that in case laws forbid it the Organizers are unable to hold the competition. Furthermore, in case the competition cannot take place due to legal restrictions or public health issues the Organizers bear no responsibility for any damage resulting from the cancellation and thus no claims can be made towards the Organizers.

Updates about Swedish Covid-19 restrictions will be communicated closer to the event.

Negative PCR test or Covid-19 pass might be necessary for all participants, we will inform about this closer to the event.

GDPR: By entering the event all participants accept that personal data are collected by the Organizing Committee and such data are stored and used by the OC, and when necessary, third parties, for the purposes only of their participation in the competition.

Information summary:

1. The office of the Organizing Committee will be located in the Ice Rink and will be at your disposal from Thursday 3 March evening to Sunday 6 March evening, during the competition and practice time. Registration at the office upon arrival is mandatory for all participants.

2. Deadline for entries: January 31. [Svenska åkare tas in i anmälningsordning, först in prioriteras.](#) Planned Program Content form must also be sent in by February 20.

3. Payment of entry fee must be made no later than February 20. The entry fee will be partially refunded only if a medical certificate can be presented. Full refunding of fee if there are late restrictions against travelling to Sweden due to covid-19. After the draw there will be no refunding of the fee. Draw for all categories: Wednesday 2 March evening at 19.00

4. Detailed time schedule for the competition will be sent out with the confirmation. Depending on the number of participants we might have to adjust the preliminary schedule. Schedule for practice ice will also be sent out with confirmation.

5. The organizer cannot arrange transportation to and from airport, boat and hotel for participants.

7. Covid-19 – we will follow the developments and the restrictions from the Swedish government. We will post any new information we get on our Facebook and web. All participants are advised to monitor local and international rules – as these might change with short notice! Proof of vaccine status or negative PCR test might be required to participate.
